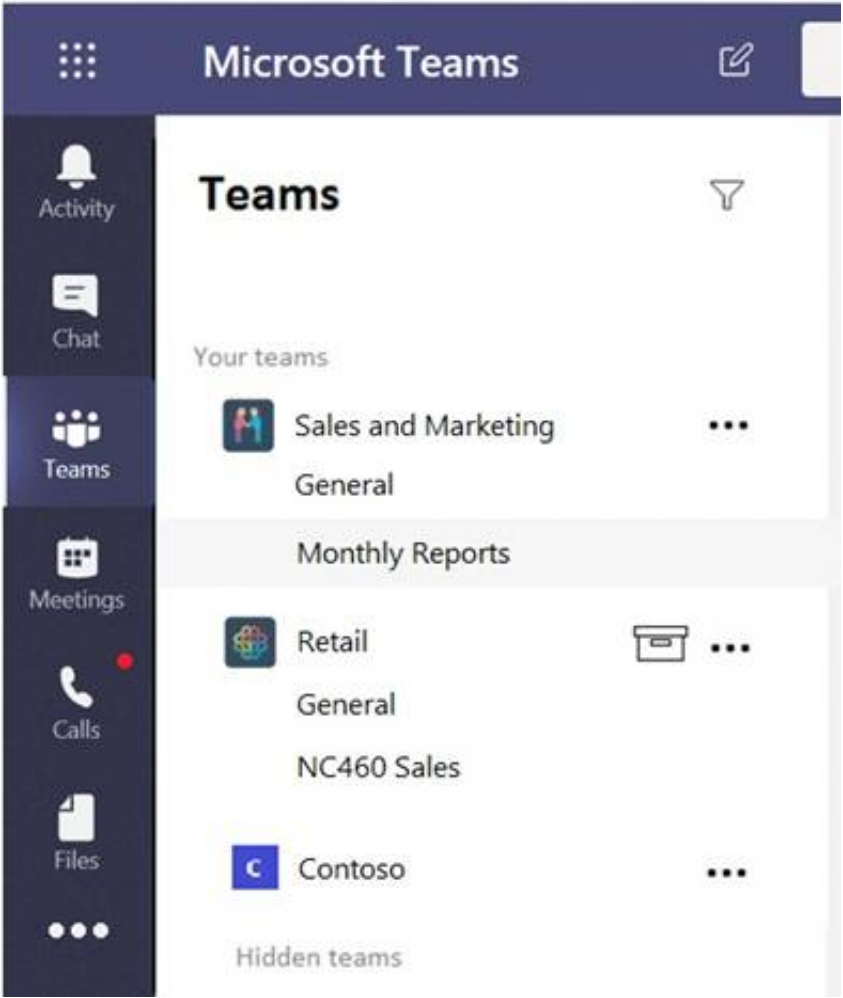

? To see whether Teams calls use TCP or UDP, you need to add Transport Protocol as a dimension to the report. To do this, select Add dimension, and then select Transport Protocol from the drop-down list.

? The report will show the distribution of TCP and UDP usage for Teams calls based on the selected report type.

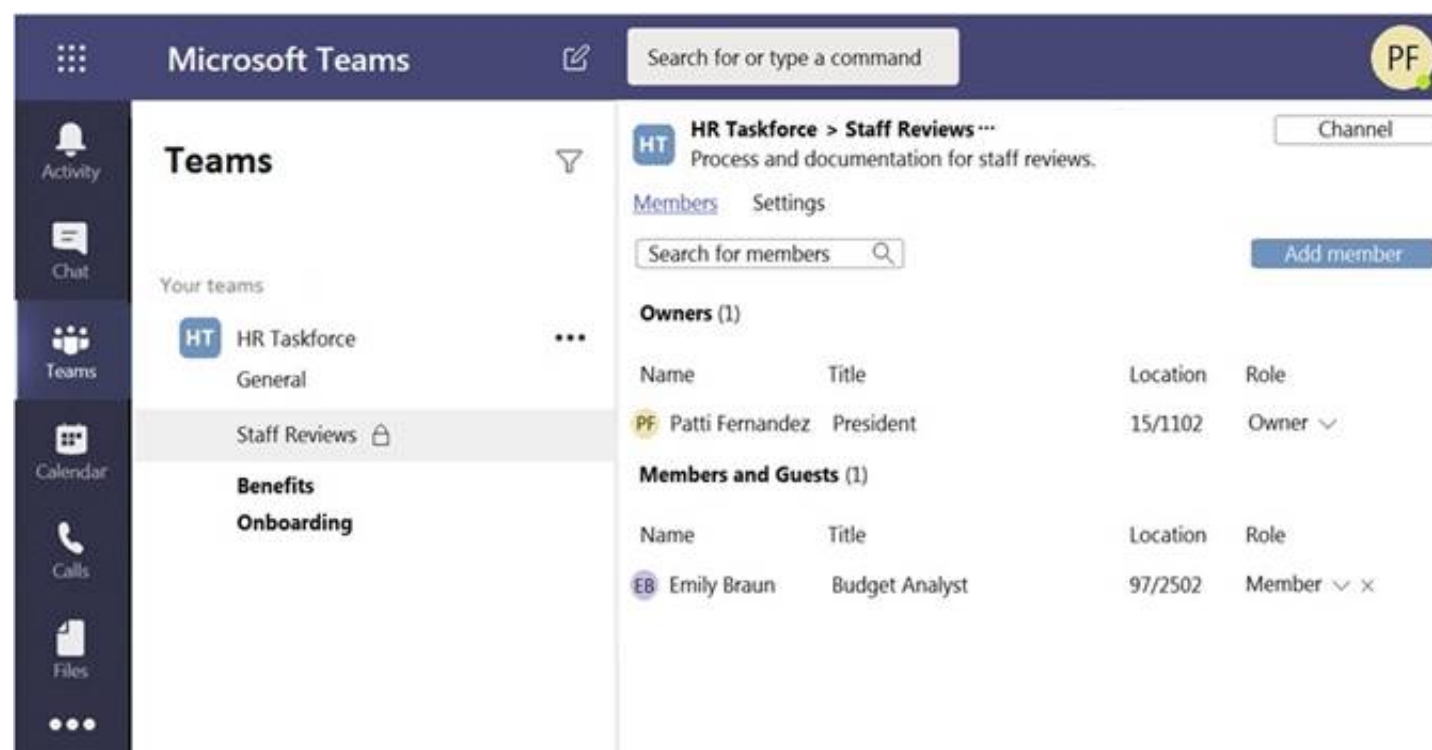
